## MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT, PUBLIC HEALTH AND FOOD SAFETY

Over 20% of food expenditure in Europe is spent on food which is thrown away. How can the EU ensure a better use of food we produce and buy?

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## The European Youth Parliament,

- A. Noting with deep concern how much food goes wasted and thrown away,
- B. Acknowledging that much of the food is thrown away because of the expiration date,
- C. Noting with regret that many food chains and restaurants throw away food that was not sold fresh instead of donating it,
- D. Deeply concerned that food waste decomposition causes increasing of greenhouse gas, which contributes to global warming,
- E. Having studied that quarter of food waste could help one billion starving people worldwide;
- 1. Encourages local farmers situated close to big cities to gather leftovers (for example old pastry and egg shells) from restaurants, school canteens and people's homes once a week and feed it to farm animals;
- 2. Requests supermarkets to cheapen food closer to its expiration date;
- 3. Calls upon both citizens and restaurants to donate unused food which would otherwise be thrown away to charity;
- 4. Recommends not to dump food on landfill sites;
- 5. Urges transport frozen products to countries with high starvation rate.
