### EVERYTHING YOU EVER WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT PARDUBICE

Pardubice is a remarkable city situated in the northern part of the Czech Republic with 90,000 inhabitants. It is the capital of the Pardubice Region and lies on the confluence of two rivers, the Elbe and the Chrudimka, 95 kilometres east from Prague. Pardubice is a city with a rich historical background and eventful present times. The oldest preserved reference to the city dates back to the 13th century. The first great aristocratic family were the Lords of Pernštejn, after whom the famous beer Pernštejn was named.

Every year, various cultural and social events take place there, such as Pardubice Music Spring, Festival of Laughter, City Festivities or Aviation Fair at the Pardubice Airport. The city is well-known for sports events, like the speedway competition Golden Helmet of Pardubice or the Great Pardubice Steeplechase Run (which has been taking place annually ever since 1874). One thing to know about Pardubice is that it provides the best gingerbread made in the whole Czech Republic.



### **ABOUT EYP**

European Youth Parliament in Czech Republic (EYP CZ) is a student apolitical non profit organisation which falls under the pan-European project European Youth Parliament (EYP), which embodies one of the biggest platforms for extracurricular education.

The European Youth Parliament is a unique educational programme which brings together young people from all over Europe to discuss current topics in a parliamentary setting. As a network of independent associations, EYP is present in 40 European countries and organises almost 600 events every year. The EYP network organises almost 1.500 days of EYP activity every year, involving close to 35.000 participants. Thousands of young people are active as volunteers all over Europe, making EYP a programme truly for young people, by young people.




## DRESS CODE EXPLAINED

International Session (IS)	the biggest, longest and the most prestigious session of them all, attended by delegates from the whole Europe and the world beyond
Officials	collective name for Organisers, Chairs, Media Team and others, who participate in the session
Chairs' Team	
President	the supervisor of a session's quality, he/she is also the Chairs' leader
Vice-President (VP)	helps the president to lead Chairs
Chairperson (Chair)	leader of a committee, it is his/her responsibility to lead the De- legates through the session and help them to create a resolution
Media Team	
Editor	the leader of the Media Team, he/she organises and puts out their projects, works with them on the concept of so the called Session Media Coverage
Editorial Assistant (EA)	he/she helps the Editor as his assistant
Media Team Member /	documents the whole session, creates its atmosphere - takes
Journalist (MTM / Journo)	pictures, records videos, comes up with "non-academic" activi- ties, works on his/her own projects
Orga Team	
Head Organiser (HO)	leader of the Organising Team, which prepares the whole session
Organiser (Orga)	a person, who prepares and does everything that's needed
Jury	
Head of Jury	organises the work of other Jurors, has the main word and an- nounces the results
Juror / Member of the Jury	oversees the work of Delegates and along with other Jurors se- lects Delegates, who then attend an NSC/IS
